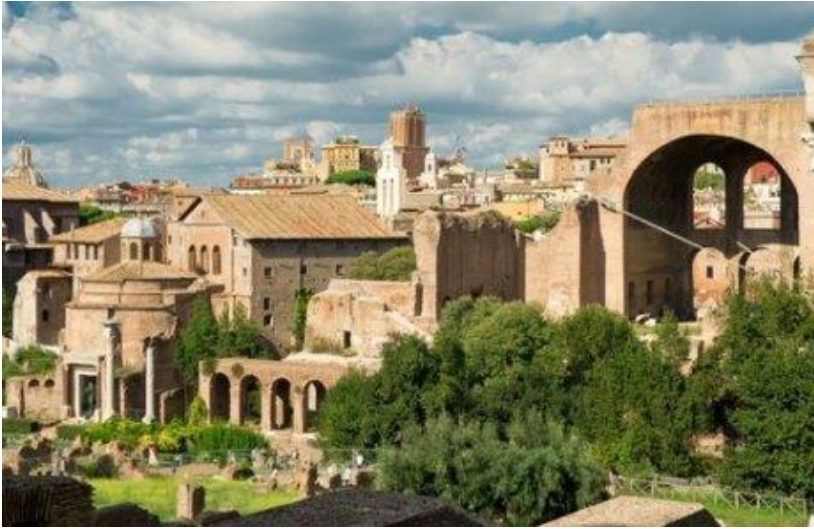


## *Heritage Choir Newsletter #8 – Rome, Italy*
